The Elizabeth Fry Society of Saskatchewan (EFS-SK) is a non-profit charitable organization located in the province of Saskatchewan and incorporated for the purpose of working with and advocating for the women and girls in the justice system, particularly those who are or are at risk of being criminalized. It is an affiliated member of the Canadian Association of the Elizabeth Fry Societies (CAEFS).

Duties:

- Assist in the case management and support for clients.
- Provide crisis intervention and support for high risk clients
- Assist clients and supports with risk reduction case plans
- Assist clients in accessing services with other agencies (including income support, employment, counseling, addiction services, mental health service, etc.)
- Make referrals or recommendations to other professionals or agencies.
- Working as part of an interdisciplinary team to create case plans for clients

Preferred Skills & Education:

- Post-secondary education in the human services field, equivalent experience or a combination of both.
- Strong understanding of the complex women and girls face in the criminal justice system
- Maintain strict confidentiality and appropriate boundaries
- Knowledge of the justice system
- Competence, training and sensitivity with respect to Indigenous cultures and traditions, trauma-informed care and gender-based care.
